Care and maintenance

Wipe the surface with a cloth. Damp wipe with detergent solution. Then rub dry with a cloth. Remove stains with detergents that do not contain abrasives. Never use steel wool.

Wipe the surface with a cloth. Damp wipe with detergent solution. Then rub dry with a cloth. Wipe dry with a dry cloth. Avoid sharp objects on the surface, since it can get scratched.
