Our large Relief hook rail in powder-coated orange aluminium extends the clean lines of the Relief dressers onto your wall. At 123 cm wide, it offers generous hanging space for bags, jackets, scarves and everyday accessories, while the fine-structure finish adds a subtle texture that feels calm and considered. Use it in larger hallways, wardrobes or shared spaces where several people need a clear, shared place for their things, or mount it above a 123 cm Relief dresser to create a unified, vertical storage zone. The slim profile keeps it visually light, so you gain practical storage without adding bulk, and the colour and proportions tie in naturally with the rest of the Relief series. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
