Our large Relief hook rail extends the clean lines of the Relief dressers onto your wall, giving you generous hanging space and a calm, ordered look. At 123 cm wide, it suits larger hallways, wardrobes or shared spaces where several bags, jackets or accessories need a clear place to live. The slim, powder-coated aluminium profile in ash keeps the expression light while the fine-structured surface adds a subtle tactility that ties in with the rest of the Relief series. Use it on its own as a graphic, horizontal accent, or mount it above or near a 123 cm Relief dresser to create a coherent storage zone for everyday items such as coats, bags or kitchen textiles. Wherever you place it, it helps you keep surfaces clear and your space visually connected. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
