Our small Relief hook rail in powder-coated aluminium brings discreet order to compact spaces. At 41 cm wide, it sits neatly in a narrow hallway, bathroom or beside a Relief dresser of the same width, creating a calm, coherent look. The fine-structure grey finish in RAL 7043 ties in with the Relief series and blends easily with most interiors. Use it to keep everyday pieces close at hand – bags, jackets, kitchen towels or smaller accessories – without cluttering surfaces. On its own it offers practical hanging space where you need it most; combined with other Relief elements, it becomes part of a clear, continuous storage line through your home. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
