Use it in a narrow hallway, bathroom or next to a dresser to keep surfaces clear and essentials within easy reach, or combine several rails to build a consistent look across your home. Wherever you place it, it adds both functional storage and a calm, coherent connection to the wider Relief series. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
