Our small Relief hook rail in ash powder-coated aluminium offers a neat way to keep everyday things close to hand. At 41 cm wide, it sits comfortably in narrow hallways, compact bathrooms or beside a Relief dresser without taking over the wall. You can hang bags, jackets, kitchen towels or smaller accessories and clear space from surfaces and floors. The fine-structured finish picks up the same calm, graphic expression as the Relief dressers, so it works just as well on its own as it does paired with a matching 41 cm unit. Used together, they create a clear, coherent line of storage that feels ordered even when in daily use. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
