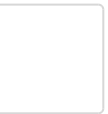

Our medium Relief hook rail in white powder-coated aluminium lines up neatly with the 82 cm Relief dresser, creating a calm, continuous look on the wall. The slim profile and evenly spaced hooks give you generous hanging space for everyday pieces without visual clutter. Use it in an entryway for coats and bags, in the kitchen for towels and utensils, or in a bedroom for accessories and outfits. At 82 cm wide, it works well on its own or paired with other Relief elements to build a coherent, practical storage wall that keeps what you need close at hand and off the floor. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
