The fine-textured finish and soft NCS S 2005-Y20R tone echo the Relief dressers, so it sits naturally above or beside a matching 82 cm unit or works on its own as a subtle accent on the wall. Slim in depth, it keeps to the wall and leaves the room feeling open while still adding practical storage and a clear visual link to the rest of the Relief series. Available in three different sizes reflecting the widths of the chests of drawers from Relief. The smallest is 41 cm, the medium-sized is 82 cm, and the largest is 123 cm.
